Buder Permits Issued in November - 18 Year to Date - 297

OLD BUSINESS:

- ◆ Mike Moll reported that the net proceeds from Extravaganza 2006 was \$206.47
- ◆ Mall Show: Chesterfield Mall is no longer a suitable venue for a Mall Show because a carousel has been installed in the display area we need. However, Chesterfield management is looking for an alternate site at another Westfield Mall.
- ◆ Buder Park reservation requests were turned in by Whirley Birds and Laf. Esq. Other clubs are urged to do so as soon as possible
- ◆ We have three volunteers to put up and support a GSLMA web site. Dr. Mike Reschak (Aero Pilots), Bill Marvel (Laf. Esq.), and Roger Waggner (St. Louis Rocketry Assn). It was agreed that GSLMA should establish a new board position of Web Master for the person who is responsible to set up and maintain the GSLMA site. Also, GSLMA should be the owner of the Domain Name for the site – not an individual. The Domain Name for the site was selected, and funding was authorized to purchase the name.

NEW BUSINESS:

- ◆ Steve Mizerany suggested that GSLMA stage an "Open House" event in the spring of 2007; the main purpose being to allow non-AMA individuals to fly on a Buddy Box. More discussion in January.
- ◆ GSLMA has been asked to support a static display of model aircraft and a simulator at the Midwest Aviation Conference and Trade Show on Saturday January 20, 2007. The event will be held at St. Louis Univ. campus, Busch Student Center.
- ◆ The Boy Scout Rocket Derby is scheduled for May 19, 2007. GSLMA is asked to stage demo flights of model aircraft as part of that event.
- ◆ GSLMA has also been asked to participate in a meeting of the St. Louis Aviation Assn. with a static display and possible demo flights. The event will be held May 5-6, 2007 at Parks Airport. More info to come.

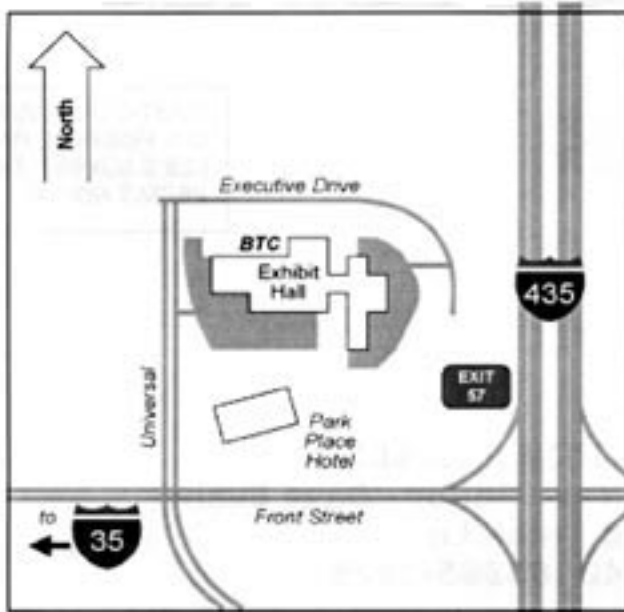
