Phantom Flyers Club Meeting Minutes March 18, 2018

Vice-President Don Grzina opened the meeting at 7:00 pm at Mark Twain Hobby. Jan could not make the meeting. There were 9 members including one visitor attendance. The visitor was Harold Weavers son Eric.

Tech Session

Club visitor Eric came to demonstrate his Apeman motion activated game camera. The camera can record 8 to 12 M Pixel resolution and cost \$72 including memory card. Several videos of wildlife were shown in pretty good detail. The camera is a possible counter measure to the vandalism occurring regularly at the field. The camera may not work if it is not close enough to activate the motion sensor and may be too far to get useful information about the vehicle doing the damage. It was suggested e hide it in the Frequency Board enclosure after cutting some holes for the camera.

Secretary's Report

The Club currently has 37 regular members. The February Meeting Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report

Club finances were reviewed by Jose. The Club Insurance was paid.

GSLMA Report

Harold Weaver provided a GLSMA report. GLSMA has a new President - Fred Cronenwett. He is active in control line and judging scale events. GLSMA is planning an event on Model Aviation Day. Their website has been improved and Harold thought it was pretty good. They will add more fencing for the new drone racing area.

Field Managers Report

- Our field is getting vandalized weekly. We discussed putting up T-posts to prevent access. They are listed at \$2.89 per post. It was felt we should make them very visible so as not to intentionally cause damage to the intruder for fear of lawsuit.
- Don called the Highway Department to clear the drainage ditch to hopefully discourage the vandal from driving onto our field.
- Don will put out an email to schedule a work party day to repair the runway.

** A motion was approved to cover the cost of asphalt repair material approximately \$140.

Activities Chair Report

- Vista Contests are being scheduled around MSVA events. We will try on Sunday at noon. MSVA will have second Saturday of the month RES contest and third Saturday of the month 2m events.
- A possible scale event was considered
- Our Pattern contest is scheduled for the last week in September.
- There will be Float Fly's at Elfrink in Jun and July
- PFRC Fun Fly is scheduled for 1st weekend in August
- Wright City Fun Fly is scheduled for the second weekend in September
- An Open House was discussed as a member appreciation event. The event should include food and drinks. We need a CD for this event.
- Larry discussed MSVA contests and asked permission to post invitations in our Club Newsletter the Carrier Wave. Ed White Ok'd it.

Old Business

The Meeting focused on a dues increase for 2019. At the current membership level our dues will not allow us to break even on club expenses. There is much concern about losing members by raising dues and limiting the increase to a minimum but enough to support expenses. To do this we would need a \$15 dollar increase, raising Membership Dues to \$150. This would be the same fee that the Spirits charge for their club. This would not be enough to add to the club savings needed to cover a major maintenance expense such as a replacement lawnmower. If such an expense was necessary we would be forced to do an assessment like we did for the roof.

There are Bylaws governing dues increases:

- The increase must be approved by 3/4 of the Club Officers and all 4 Board Members
- The increase must be for a specific amount
- The Club Members must be given a 7 day notice before the Club Meeting that the increase is voted on.

• The increase must be approved by a majority vote at the Club Meeting

It was recommended that Jan send out a notice to the Club explaining the situation.

Jan sent an email on March 10 to solicit club members' interest and to encourage participation in club activities. There were some responses mostly centering on an Open House noncompetitive event with food. Possibly having a combined swap meet. Mitch also mentioned the Boeing Open House as a potential recruiting opportunity.

• Website continues to be updated.


• Flood clean up – not much needs to be done.
