Dave sent us this picture on 2/01/2017 from Arizona and writes:


'Flew six missions with my Mosquito today. Hope all you folks up north are doing well, we here in Mesa remember why we come here each year.' Dave

Well, it's official. We are going to host the 2017 Precision Aerobatic Nationals at Blytheville, Arkansas. We have an enthusiastic community that has gone above and beyond to make this event occur in Blytheville. We have an exceptional flying site. Blytheville is immediately accessed from Interstate 55 an hour north of Memphis. The motels are very nice and there are plenty of good restaurants.

It will be from Tuesday July 25 thru July 29. The pilots meeting and opening ceremony will be the 25th. This year will be slightly different in that we are going to include Sportsman. They will not receive the same awards as all other classes but they will fly for 3 days. The purpose of the class has been as an intro to pattern and will be treated as such. Intermediate and advanced will fly 3 days. Masters will fly 3 days then have a finals. FAI will fly 2 days prelims, 1 day semis, and 1 day finals. The details of all that will be made available with your packet.
