Minutes of the Phantom Flyers RC Club meeting on 20 December 2021

The December club meeting was held via Zoom and opened at 7:02 PM. VP and Prez-elect Dan Dierking chaired the meeting. Nine club members were present.

Tech Session: Don Grzina presented a small, totally self-contained inclinometer that you read from a smartphone via Bluetooth. He plans to use two to set up control surface throws.

Secretary's Report - A motion was made and passed to accept the minutes of the November meeting as published in the December Carrier Wave.

Treasurer's Report - The club is still solvent. The full Treasurer's report is available to any club member upon request. Membership renewals are due now. Please get them in. Don Grzina paid by a credit card service since he does not have a PayPal account. If you are paying dues by PayPal, please consider adding some additional to cover the PayPal fee of approx. \$5-6.

Safety Officer's Report - Safety Officer Dave Evans was in attendance. No safety issues were raised.

Field Manager's Report - The grass has (probably) quit growing. A small committee was again formed to look at options for a new mower. Still searching for something that is suitable and affordable. Someone parked a motorcycle at the field. It was a bit beat up. The battery and had been removed and it had no license plates. The St Charles County Sheriff was notified and an officer came to look at it. They ran the VIN number and found that it was not reported stolen and had never been registered in the state of MO. Since it was abandoned on private property, they told us we could have it removed. We left it for a few days and it was removed for us.

Activities Chair Report - We have no more events for the year and currently no Christmas party is planned. The next event will be the traditional New Year's Day Snow Fly.

GSLMA Report - They plan to do an AMA Model Aviation Day event. Also plans are in work to resurface the asphalt.

Winter Building Season

I have a list of models that I need to have completed for the 2022 flying season. The first was to put the final paint scheme on my Byron Originals F-16 that I converted to EDF. The next is to complete my Douglas D-558-1 Skystreak that I started in mid-2020. After that I may finish my scratch-built twin 90mm EDF F-15 or start a new project (T-7A Redtails) but the focus, right now are the F-16 and Skystreak. I plan to have them flight ready by early March. I also have some repairs to do on other models.

The progress on the F-16 has been good. The weather improved enough for the painting process to commence in the middle of December. The painting is done, decals printed and applied. The model transitioned from maiden to Primer Camo and finally NSAWDC (TOPGUN) can be seen below. I still need to strengthen the area under the canopy and add a nose wheel door. After painting this model, and getting lots of debris in the paint from the very windy conditions outside (I painted it in the garage), I have decided to give Latex paint a try on my next model. With rattle can spray paint (Rust-O-Leum) you are limited to what you can do if debris or errors are made in the process. With Latex it could be removed or re-sanded if needed and re-applied as needed.







The Douglas Skystreak is also going well. I had to relocate the horizontal fin lower on the vertical fin to improve the look. When I was drawing it in CAD I screwed up the location on the fuselage and therefore all the measurements. I knew it was incorrect and drew a separated assembly above it with the correct measurements, but I never used it, until now. Now I need to fill in the opening for the old location and then cut the openings for the elevator and rudder servos. The servos have been ordered and should be here soon.

Since I can't do much else, I decided to work on modifying the E-Flite 80mm F-4 Phantom main retracts to fit this project. The wheels are about 2.65 inches in diameter and the Skystreak will require a diameter of 2.45 inches. I chucked the foam tires into a drill and used 100 grit sand paper to achieve the proper diameter, they are too wide but good enough. The strut length is also too long, by about .5 inch and had to be trimmed and the set screw holes need to be drilled and tapped.




