

Jose and I showed up at the field this month. My plan was to maiden my recently acquired Freewing T-45 Goshawk and Jose was practicing his landings. I had my camera with me so Jose used it to capture one of my flights









Li-Ion Packs the New Round Cells

I have been following a slow moving trend in RC electric aviation on the use of Li-Ion cells for flight packs. Li-Ions have some advantages over the current Li-Po packs but for me the robust nature and the potential increase of cycles before replacements. The downsides of these are the low available current discharge and you have assemble the packs.

When I started flying electric powered models, I would order my pre-assembled NiCad packs, much like we order our Lipo packs today. At times I had to order individual cells, aka round cells, and assemble packs for a particular configuration.

Fast forward to today and the cycle maybe repeating for me!

Batteries of choice are the Samsung 21700 40T 4000 mAh. The specs claim these are 35 ampere rated cells which could work well in parkflyers and drones. For my application, EDF (electric ducted fan) they will have to be put in parallel to achieve 70 amps.

I purchased battery holders off eBay to construct groups 6S packs. I also had to purchase balance leads for each pack. These first couple of packs will be tested as 6S/2P. That is a spec total of 70amp at 8000mAh but they can be briefly pushed to a higher current if proper cooling is available. It should be noted that with NiCad and NiMh, the cells layed next to each other. The holders for the Li Ion ensure the cells don't touch and this is important for cooling and cell longevity.







Although the thought of carrying around 12 cells in a model designed for 6 sounds heavy but Li-Ion packs configured in a 6S/2P 8000mAh weighed in at 2 pound. My Turnigy 6S 8000mAh 25C Lipo weighs in at 2 pounds 8 onuces and the RoaringTop 6S 5800 35C weighs in a 1 pound 11 ounces. Flight testing will start soon.

My ultimate plan is a 12S/3P configuration (12000mAh at 105amps) for a big model.
