# **Event Reports:**

### Saturday, May 23 was a Great Day for a Glider Contest! - Ed White

We got a late start because the CD had a morning commitment. My apologies to all. Here are the standings:

We flew five rounds. Scoring was done per AMA rulebook for Thermal Duration. Each round was normalized to 1000 points. We flew five rounds and one (lowest normalized score) round for each flyer was dropped. The numbers shown are the sum of 4 best rounds.

#### Nearly one third of all flights exceeded 6 minutes (12 out of 37).

Jim West won two rounds and Jan, Emery and Kevin each won one round. In one round, I had a time of 7:01 plus landing points and did not win the round. I do believe we're all getting better at this. Also, top 4 finishers were 2 electrics (2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>) and 2 "pure" glider Vistas (1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>). I'm still not seeing an advantage for either.

For the record: Jim flew his Vista, and won, and <u>still</u> complained that after he bought the Vista people started switching to electrics and Radians. I flew Radian EP, Jan flew Vista, Emery Radian EP, Jose Vista EP, Larry Sagita (not EP), Kevin something made of foam EP, Harold Radian EP, Don - uh sorry Don I forgot what it is called, but it is really very pretty - Chrysalis! (I did remember).

The hi-start had new rubber on it. We flew with only one hi-start and may have saved some time by not having to untangle them. By the time you read this we will have had the second contest of the year. Jan was CD and inexplicably rewarded for it by scoring higher than I did. So if you want to move up in the standings, just volunteer to CD the next contest. Probably sometime in July. Make plans to join us. If you don't have a glider, come out anyway and we'll get you fixed up.








# 2017 Innsbrook Float Fly
