Minutes of the Phantom Flyers RC Club meeting on 15 March 2021

#### Phantom Flyers RC Club Meeting Minutes April 19 2021

President Bill Ahrens opened the meeting at 6:25. The meeting was held at the Flying Site. There were 10 members in attendance. The weather turned and became very cold and windy.

#### **Tech Session**

Bill Ahrens talked about new retractable landing he bought for his jet Viper. They are very sturdy and had shock absorbing spring knuckles that worked very well. Unfortunately, Bill could not remember where he bought them or what brand they were, only that they came from China.

#### Secretary's Report

The meeting minutes from the last month were approved. The Secretary could not make the meeting so Jim West took the minutes.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

Jose reported that the club is solvent and doing good.

#### Field Managers Report

Red Mower (Exmark - Zero Turn) Problems:

- The mower now has a new 23 HP engine. The old 20 HP engine seized up in the shop when it was being repaired and the crankshaft broke.
- The mower was in the shop for oil leaks and the oil pan was unknowingly damaged during the repair. The mower was test run and then failed.
- The cost of the replacement engine was covered by Steve Nort (apologize if I got the name wrong), a friend of Chris Sostman, who was doing the repair. The repair cost to the club was \$600 which was the original cost to fix the oil leak.
- There was agreement to send Steve a thank you card for his service.
- With a new motor we may not need to replace the mower

Green Craftsman Mower

- The deck has been repaired twice now and could fail again at anytime. We could probably repair it if it failed again
- The battery is low and needs to be replaced (which it was later)

A volunteer work crew repaired the runway with polymeric sand which apparently works great. It cost \$17 per bag and 4 bags were used. Applying a sealer was discussed.

An asphalt company was contacted to evaluate the cost of repairing the runway.

- To lay 1 inch of asphalt over the runway the cost is: \$34,000
- To repair the longitudinal cracks the cost is: \$7,000

The field mowing schedule has been sent out and revised.

#### Field Managers Report (cont'd)

The runway will be sprayed for weeds this Friday

The field was cut by Don and Jack last Friday

The locks are not working well. It was recommended to make sure that the locks are locked facing down so that water does not enter the mechanism.

The cable was replaced for the gate, the old on broke.

\*Security cameras have been installed

The Porta Potty and the Frequency Board has been painted and look fabulous!

The flight work tables need to be repaired. They are falling apart.

#### **Activities Report**

May 1<sup>st</sup> is the Swap meet. Willie will be cooking pulled pork. The picnic tables will be used for lunch and not display. The gate will open at 8:30. There will be a raffle. The entry fee will be \$5.00. The start time is 9:00.

The Open House was briefly discussed. We will offer \$100 new member for the day of the Open House.
