I received this email from club member Dan Able, he writes:

'Hello Kevin,

I have a couple ideas to suggest for the CW and meetings. I know it is easy to suggest ideas and finding someone to do it is another animal.

That being said:

1) Something along the lines of a segment called: Two Minute Tip

Have someone either live or share a video during a club meeting give a tip on a technique. Also include a written version in the CW.

Example: How to discharge a battery after flying to a safe storage level and why.

Example: Putting after run oil into a nitro engine after a day of flying and why.

These are rather simple examples-need someone more creative than I am to think up a list. I would like to ask members to submit ideas for topics they would like to DO or hear. We can set up an email address (offered by Ed White) like <a href="mailto:twominutetip@phantomflyersrc.com">twominutetip@phantomflyersrc.com</a> and every month publish the ideas sent in by emails and share during the Zoom club meetings.

2) A section in the CW: Club History or Back In The Day or Looking Back

Go back thru past CW and find an article on an event, a member's model, club visitor or notable member and reprint that section of the past CW in a current CW.

3) Were any of you a member of the club when the meetings were held in members houses? Interesting part of the meeting was to see the members workshop and current project (or many 1/2 finished projects). During the Zoom meeting ask members to show their work space or current project. Maybe show systems or components that aren't popular currently. I.E. a diesel-powered engine, Goldberg servo actuated retracts, a Galloping Ghost radio, the oldest model you currently own/pictures of oldest model memory etc.
