### Phantom Flyers R/C Club Meeting Minutes - 17 April 2023

**Attendees:** 8 club members were in attendance at the field which started at 6:32 pm. People I recorded were: Ed White, Mitch Galatioto, Dan Abel, Don Grzina, Don Bollinger, Mike Wallis, Jim West and Bill Reape. **New Members:** None in attendance.

**Technical Session:** Ed White was giving away some batteries from Al Bone's estate, but no tech session was held.

**Secretary's Report:** There was an issue with people not receiving their Carrier Wave, so March meeting minutes approval was postponed until the next meeting.

Treasurer's Report: Jose had car troubles and was not in attendance, so no report was provided.

**Safety Officer's Report:** We discussed Open House safety and reminded everyone that if you see any issues or violations, please point it out so that everyone remains safe.

**Field Manager:** Please let Don Grzina know if you are willing to mow this year so he can create the mowing list. The runway is in pretty good shape, but Don is looking into material to perform minor crack filling. In addition, Don found a roller to rent to smooth the field and needs a volunteer to help tow the 2 ton twin drum roller. A motion was made and passed to authorize \$250 to rent and transport the roller.

Ed brought up that we have not changed any of the locks on the container in some time and that one of his keys does not work on one of the container locks. He also stated the keys in the port-a-john need to be removed as keys to that lock may be in hands of people no longer in club and creates a risk to someone gaining access to the container. He also recommended removing the lock on the winch as it served no purpose. Ed will look into re-keying a few of the locks to increase container security.

Activities Report: Dan Abel provided the following.

**Open House** - April 29th at the field. Bill Reape volunteered to be the Contest Director. Ed White will provide the hold-harmless declaration form that all participants must sign at the event. A motion was made and approved to provide \$100 membership dues to anyone joining the club at the event.
